ATTENDANCE

The schedule is based on in-class sessions. Students are required to compete practical hours in a clinical setting and must be able to demonstrate and evaluated in-person to be granted a pass. If travel for study is not possible by the student, theoretical study online will be accommodated where scheduled, with the practical session occurring at the next possible in-class scheduled intake or if alternate arrangements have been made with the instructor (additional fees apply). Note: Delivery options may be modified. For example, courses may be online and course hours may be adjusted to accommodate practical work under supervision to ensure competencies and performance indicators.
